Moving a historic building is sometimes the only way to save it from demolition. It is a procedure that requires considerable skill and experience.

This 54-page document by John Obed Curtis, published originally by the United States Department of the Interior, and available solely from IASM, presents examples of buildings moved in Philadelphia in 1799, a brick house in New York in the 1830s, a seven-story hotel in Boston and a Courthouse in Nebraska in 1869. These and count-

less other examples are contained in the publication.

Contents include: Community and Federal Involvement, Selecting a Moving Contractor, Specifications and Licenses, Selecting the Best Procedure for the Move, Planning the Route, Documentation, Interim Protection Prior to the Mover, Selecting and Preparing the New Site, Preparing the Structure for the Move, and a case study of the Relocation of the Gruber Wagon Works in Berks County, Pennsylvania.
