2005 Scholarship Awards Application

The IASM Scholarship Program is sponsored for the benefit of children of IASM member company employees. Thus company membership status must be current in both the year of application and the year of award.

This application form must be completed and returned as part of the total application.

Committee Responsibility

1. The Scholarship Committee shall be comprised of three members of the board of directors.
2. The chairman of the committee shall be the first past president.
3. The committee shall serve from the board meeting following the annual conference to the same board meeting the following year.
4. The committee shall be responsible for receiving the official IASM Scholarship Rules from the previous committee or the chief staff executive.
5. The committee shall produce the official application during their tenure and assure its timely circulation to the membership. The latest practical date would be mid-October.
6. The committee shall assure that notice of the IASM scholarship program is published in the official association magazine, newsletter, web site, and mailings to members.
7. The chief staff executive shall be responsible for collecting all applications.
8. The chief staff executive shall verify applicants are from qualified member companies. Applicant's company membership status must be current in both the year of application and the year of award.
9. The chief staff executive shall make copies of all qualifying applications, include evidence of their postmark date, and furnish all materials to the committee within fourteen days of the application deadline.
10. The committee shall make arrangements to judge the applications, compile a list of winners, and provide such list to the chief staff executive and the official publication of the association.
11. Applications not meeting the postmark deadline will not be considered. Incomplete or incorrectly completed applications will be rejected. Judges are not allowed to contact applicants or their member companies for any reason pertaining to the judging process.
12. Relatives and company members of the judges are allowed to apply. Judges may not judge their relative's applications. Judges are strongly urged to avoid any possible conflict of interest. Judges may excuse themselves from judging individual applications at their discretion. The judging process will work without all of the judges participating.
13. The committee may award up to, but not more than 10 scholarships per year. IASM is not required to award any scholarships in a given year. There is no existing minimum requirement for number of scholarships awarded, however judges must select a group exhibiting a high level in all criteria.
14. The committee is responsible for preparing an acknowledgement ceremony which will take place during the annual conference.
15. The committee is responsible for coordinating fund raising activities as are necessary to support the scholarship fund. The fund is not supported by the general membership fund of IASM and has no financial support other than fund raising at the annual conference.
16. The committee is responsible for directing the IASM treasurer to mail scholarship award checks to winners in a timely fashion.
17. The committee is responsible for notifying the committee chair and the association president of the need to elect replacement members if they intend to retire.

Student Responsibility

This scholarship application will not automatically guarantee the student will receive a scholarship.

The student must complete the application carefully and completely. An incomplete application will not be presented to the committee.

Ruling of the judges is final. The judges are not responsible for erroneous applications, processing errors or omissions.

Applications will only be accepted by mail. Scholarship applications must be mailed to:

Applications must be postmarked by January 10, 2005.

All transcripts and mailing fees are the responsibility of the applicant. **Applicants must provide the following:**

- A completed application form
- Most current applicable transcripts. These will be used to establish a grade point average. The grade point average is twenty-five percent of the score.

- Minimum of one letter of recommendation from an adult (not a family member).
- Essay of 200-400 words which must include at least four of the following six topics:
 1. Reason for applying for this scholarship.
 2. Show potential educational benefits to the structural moving industry.
 3. Citizenship, leadership and community involvement.
 4. Future plans, hopes and ambitions.
 5. How and why you made your career choice.
 6. How and why a person/event made an impact on you.*Your signature must conclude the essay.*
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or administrator.
- A head and shoulders photograph of yourself for publicity purposes.

It is the student's responsibility to determine if their company is a member in good standing before the application deadline. The company membership status must be current in both the year of application and the year of award.
