

# Structural Moving Industry Statistical Research

To IASM members:

The following actions have or are being taken by the International Association of Structural Movers, North Carolina and Texas Legal & Utilities Committees.

## North Carolina (NCHMA)

A Utilities Committee has been actively contacting members of NCHMA gathering requested statistical information. A compilation report of the data was presented to NCHMA members at their fall meeting last month.

These data, along with a copy of STRUCTURAL MOVER and a letter from NCHMA President Wayne Overton, were provided each congressman and senator from the state of North Carolina making the representatives aware of the house moving industry and its value to the State. The letter also included references to the fact that Structural Movers is a part of the world's largest recycling industry, the amount of tax base NCHMA has created for the State, a comparison of the dollar volume created by other trades, the dollar costs from utilities and, with the support of the North Carolina Historical Society, provided the volume of historical structures rescued from wreaking balls.

Representatives of NCHMA and IASM met in November with North Carolina officials in support of changes to chapter 20, article 16 of the North Carolina Department of Transportation code in order to remove unreasonable restriction currently in place.

## Texas (THMA)

As understood in conversation with IASM Director Donna Landers, Texas has formed a Legal & Utilities Committee (L&UC). During a seminar, members of the committee met with multiple state organizations to make the officials aware of the problems of the house moving industry regarding permits and utilities. The Texas House Movers Association (THMA) was scheduled near the end of presentations. Officials were so impressed with the committee's presentation; their time allotment was extended.

THMA has been requested to provide a written synopsis of actions by its L&UC, along with results of the seminar, in order to share factual data with other house mover organizations and their members.

## International Association of Structural Movers (IASM)

The association has an active group of directors who share a common goal of working positively with members of the association to successfully address problems of the industry, specifically with regard to permitting and utility issues.

The Legal & Utilities Committee (L&UC) encourages all IASM members to be actively involved, in a positive way, with their local Legal & Utilities Committee's efforts to collect necessary data absolutely vital to effectively address our industry's problems. If there is not a house mover's organization in your area, form one. Inactive organizations should become active. As house movers it is our responsibility to look after the health of our industry. Unless individual members assume a positive attitude and become aggressive in providing data from every move made involving permits and utilities, there is nothing the legal & utilities committees can do. They must have the data.

Members of the IASM Legal & Utilities Committee are Dan Dillabaugh, Robert Hayden, Allen Hof, Wayne Overton and Joshua Wendland.

IASM membership is composed of individualists who, when motivated, can accomplish much. I asked each of you to become positively motivated to assist on these legal and utilities efforts.
