You can't get to Corolla, NC from Virginia by automobile until you travel south from the Virginia state border to Southern Shores, just north of Kitty Hawk (where Orville and Wilber Wright made their historic flights) a distance of approximately 20 miles. Then you drive north on a narrow beach road through places named Duck, Sanderling, and past the Currituck Beach Lighthouse.

From Kitty Hawk south to Ocracoke, which is located just north of the Historic Portsmouth Village and the Ocracoke Lighthouse you will travel a distance of 75 miles, plus a short ferry ride, through places named Kill Devil Hills, Nags Head,, Rodanthe, Waves, Salvo, Avon, Buxton, past the Cape Hatteras Lighthouse, Frisco, and Hatteras. All these places are on a narrow strand of sand known as the Outer Banks.



Since the area was first settled in the 1600's, and especially more so over the past 100 years, Americans and visitors have gravitated to the area for relaxation and to feel the strong Atlantic Ocean breezes. Fishing along the coast and the inland tributaries has been a national past time for this area.
