



# *Heaviest Building Moved NOT on Rubber-Tired Dollies*

Hotel in Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin

This historic hotel, nestled on beautiful Lake Elkhart, was being renovated into luxury condominiums. Extensive foundation damage required raising the entire structure six inches for repairs. The top three floors received extensive shoring consisting of four-by-four wood posts that allowed minimal use of steel in raising the structure. The building was raised

on 19 cribs, ranging in height from 11 feet to 18 feet. Cribs were built using six-by-eight-by-four-foot crib blocks. Over 900 crib blocks were used. The building was lifted using four main beams while taking advantage of existing support beams. The building measured 110' x 80' and weighed 210 tons.
