What is included in the Power Pack Package?

Why a Modern Hydraulics/Nevada, LLC product? The association contacted IASM member vendors and requested a tender price for a Power Pack Package. Lance Renshaw, President, Modern Hydraulics/Nevada graciously contributed his company's product to the association in support of this fund raising effort.

Why a raffle? The raffle is to aid IASM generate funds for student Scholarships, develop new education products to aid the membership and to assist state, province or regional structural mover organizations financially with utility wire issues harmful to the structural moving industry.

Who should participate? Everyone. Especially IASM members, their employees, vendors/suppliers to the industry, historical organizations and their supporters, governments at all levels and everyday citizens. Since 1995 IASM has awarded approximately \$65,000 to more than 125 students for college or trade school financial assistance. It is hoped enough funds can be amassed to make the scholarship program self-sustaining.

While the structural moving industry is by its nature, a small niche market, IASM is the only official trade organization representing the industry as a whole with members in Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Great Britain, New Zealand, Peru, Sweden, The Netherlands and the United States. In order

for the association to effectively confront certain unfair situations that face the industry from time to time a substantial monetary fund must be accumulated to assist state, province or regional structural moving organizations.

Monies generated through the raffle, after expenses, will go toward these causes.

What is the time frame? The sale of tickets begins at the MidStates Housemovers Association's annual conference March 23, 2007 in Omaha, Nebraska. It will conclude immediately prior to the Recognition Dinner on Saturday, 23 February 2008 during the IASM annual conference at the Sheraton Bloomington Hotel South, Minneapolis, MN.

There is no limit on the number of tickets an individual or entity may purchase.

The winner is responsible for delivery of the Power Pack Package and any taxes that may be applicable.
